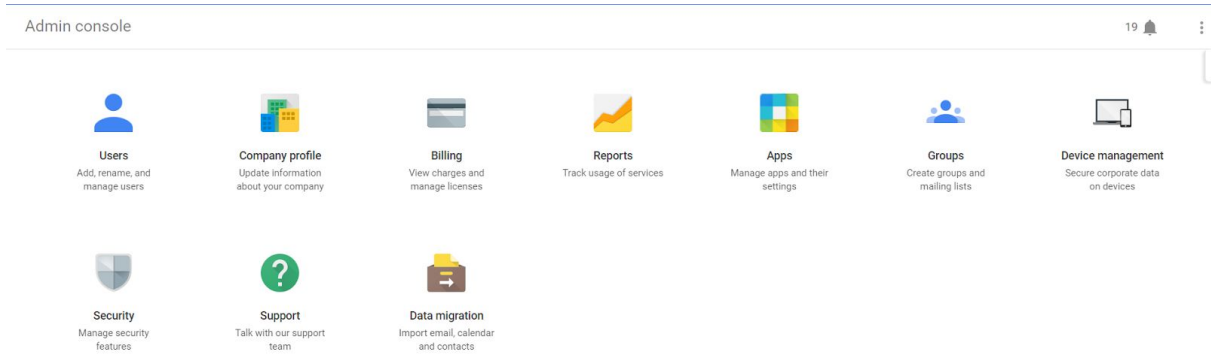
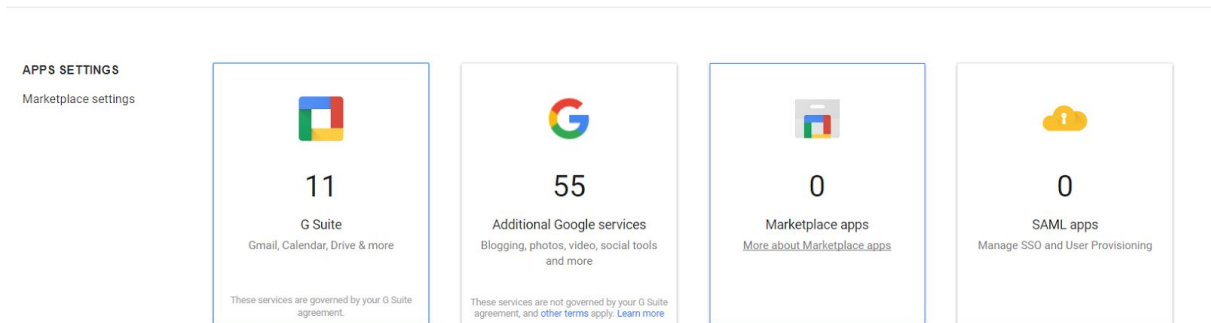


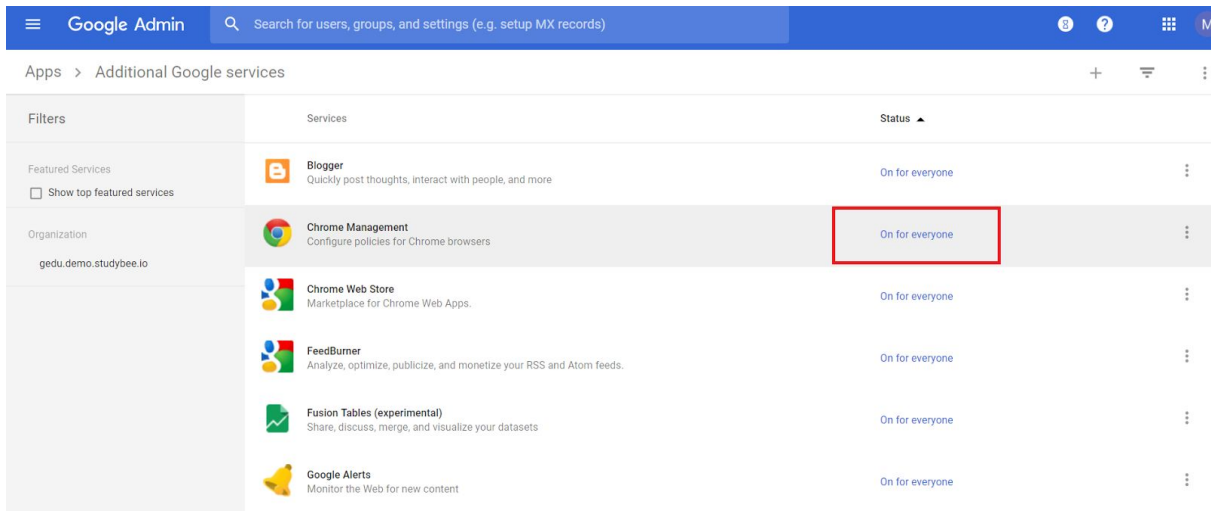
1. To install StudyBee extension on all teachers and students computers or chromebooks you need to go to [admin.google.com](https://admin.google.com) and log in to your domain. It looks something like below.



2. Click on "Apps" to go to "Apps settings", see below.



3. Click on "Additional Google services" to go to the settings below.



4. In the list it is "Chrome management" that shall be clicked on. But before clicking on this you should make sure that the function is "On for everyone" or at least for those groups that should use StudyBee. When clicking on "Chrome Management" the below is show.

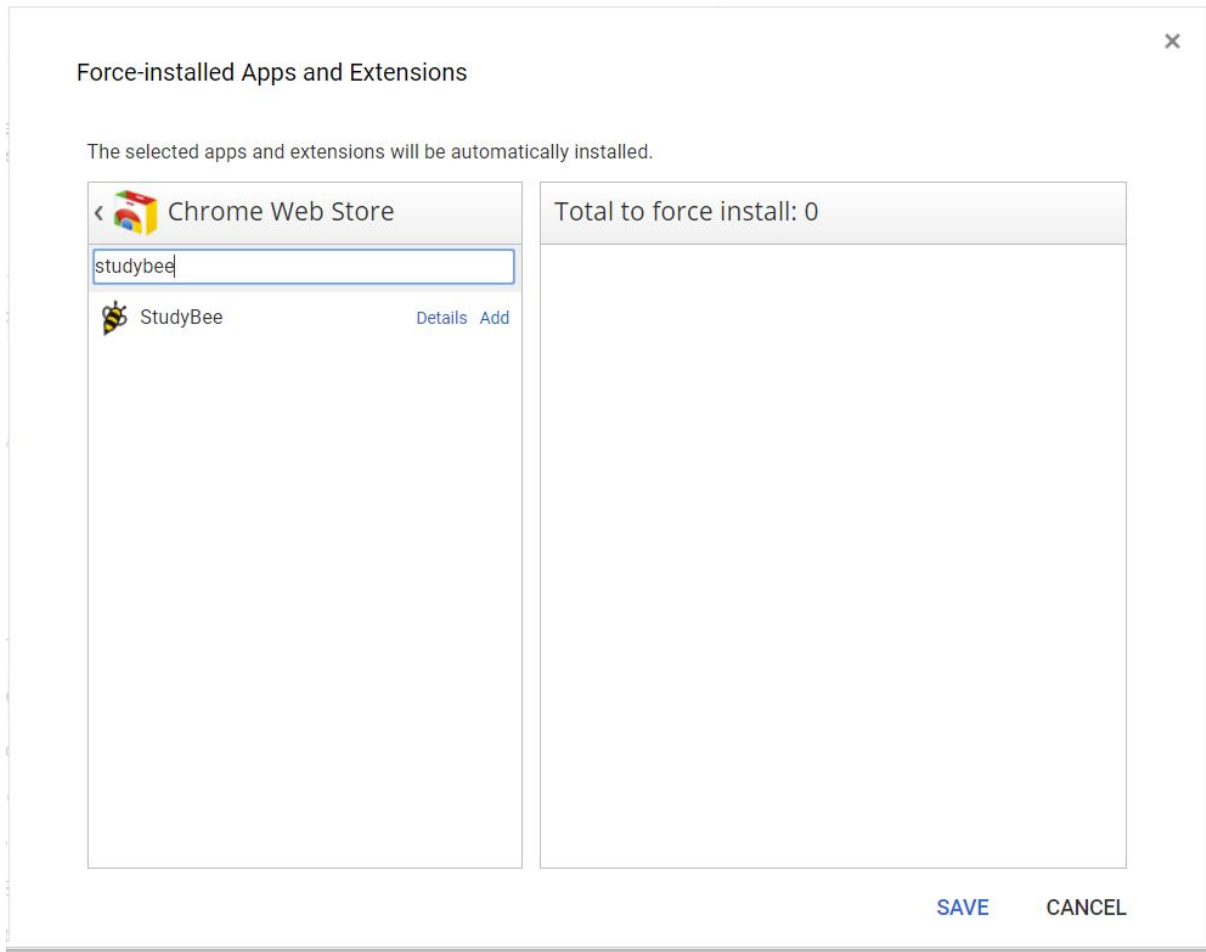

6. By clicking on “Manage force-installed apps” under Apps and Extensions you can add StudyBee for everyone in the domain. When clicking the link you will see the dialog below.



In this dialog you search in Chrome Web Store after StudyBee by writing StudyBee and hitting “Enter”. Then you will find StudyBee. By pressing “Add”, StudyBee is added for everyone in the domain or the group selected in step 3.

7. Press “Save” and return to the interface in step 5.
8. To make sure that the students not inactivate StudyBee you have to go down to “User experience” and the section “Developer Tools”. Here you select “Never allow use of built-in developer tools”, see below.
